

Explanation of Helmet Waiver:

In years past there have been some misunderstandings regarding the Helmet Waiver. Of course, it's always safer to wear a helmet when rock climbing. Having said that, there are certain occasions where helmets are not critical to safety, such as when bouldering and top roping in an area that has no potential of rock fall from above.

Our campers are required to wear helmets when lead climbing and when the guides determine that there may be potential rock fall from above.

If you do not sign the Helmet Waiver you are saying that your camper must wear a helmet at all times; when bouldering, top roping, etc. If you do sign the Waiver it gives the camper the option to wear it when the guides say it's necessary and not to wear it if the guides feel that it's not – say when bouldering.
