

LETTER OF AGREEMENT

There are several specific requirements of Smith Rock Climbing Camp, involving very serious issues.

Take some time to carefully read the following and discuss with your son or daughter. It is mandatory that the following be understood and agreed to in order to attend Smith Rock Climbing Camp.

1. There will be no alcohol, tobacco (cigarettes or smokeless), or other drugs allowed at Smith Rock Climbing Camp. We reserve the right to check the camper's person or belongings if any of the above items are suspected.
2. In addition, matches and lighters are not allowed at Smith Rock Climbing Camp. In the high desert environment where we are located, fire danger is extreme in the summer. A single match can start a small brush fire that grows to tremendous intensity, causing death and destruction in its wake.
3. It is very normal for young teenagers to develop romantic interests in other teens. If this occurs during camp, the kids involved must behave in a manner that is respectful to the other kids. Absolutely no public displays of affection other than the affection that is commonly displayed between friends. It is very uncomfortable for the other kids to be around two campers that have developed a romantic interest in each other.

Should a camper be found in possession of any one of the above mentioned items, or in violation of requirement #3, it will represent grounds for immediate expulsion from camp. The parent or guardian will be contacted and must arrange for the camper to return home immediately.
